Parking on campus with a marked media vehicle is permissible, with the exception of restricted areas including handicap spaces, fire zones (red curbs), safety zones (yellow curbs), plus spaces designated for official vehicles, services vehicles and reserved spaces. Media members in an unmarked vehicle can call 277.5813 for a temporary parking permit. UCAM has two parking spaces located behind the University Enrichment & Advisement Center (building #85), marked UCAM A70 and UCAM A71 in parking lot A. The lot is north of Johnson Field and the tennis courts.

To get to the UCAM office from parking lot A, walk to the west end of the tennis courts toward the University Advisement & Enrichment Center sign. Enter the building through the double doors and take the door to the right. Turn right at the first hallway. UCAM is the second door on the right, Suite 160.
